



BROADWAY BOUND SUMMER CAMP SESSIONS COVID-19 PROCEDURES AND SAFETY POLICIES

Dutch Apple Dinner Theatre / Broadway Bound is committed to the safety of our students, staff and families. We are following CDC guidelines related to Summer Camp programs. It is our goal, to provide a fun-filled theatrical experience while keeping a safe and healthy learning environment for all.

Students:

Must wear a mask when entering the building, whenever they leave their designated home-base spot in the building and when departing the building. Although CDC guidelines do not require a child to wear masks during the duration of activities in classes. It is recommended for your child's age group to do so and is at the discretion of the parent. The Instructors will be wearing masks at all times during the duration of the Sessions.

We will use social distancing when entering, leaving and during the majority of classes. CDC guidelines do not state that students must be kept at a 6 foot radius for camp / daycare but kept within the same group for activities. Your child's session will always have the same participants and the same instructors for each time they are in the building.

Please only bring what is needed for class: Suggestions: small bag to hold mask, personal pencil not to be shared, water bottle with your child's name on it. Please note, there will be no water fountain use. Your child should wear comfortable shoes to move in. Please do not bring separate dance shoes, what your child wears to camp session is what they will be moving in. During this Summer Sessions there will not be a snack time due to the concentrated time and to ensure safety.

All students will have a temperature check done before entering the building. If your child's temperature is over 100.4. We will have them sit down and give them a moment to relax and retake the temperature 5 minutes later. If it still is over 100.4, they will not be allowed to participate in the in-person session that day.

Students will be asked to use hand sanitizer when entering and exiting the building.

Parents:

Please drop your child off at 8:45am at the front entrance of the Dutch Apple Building. The student will be greeted by an instructor whom will guide them through the temperature check and into the theater. Parents are kindly asked to remain in your vehicle for the morning drop off. An instructor will give you thumbs up once the temperature check has been completed.

Pick up, please pull your car to the end of the sidewalk at the main entrance. Students will be exiting from our side theatre door and lining up along the side walk to the side door. We will be practicing social distancing during this process so please be patient as it may take a bit longer than previous years.

Please wear a mask if you are outside of your car.

Please complete the Waiver Form, assuming all risk for child and waive any and all liability of any kind from Dutch Apple / Broadway Palm and any of its staff, volunteers, agents and independent contractors inside the facility and including the parking lot as well as its surrounding areas.

Facility Practices:

Staff will have their temperature checked upon arrival each day.

Staff and instructors will wear a masking during all interactions with students and parents.

Staff and instructors will wash their hands before and after each class and during class at their discretion.

Staff will be directing entrance and exits of each class.

We will be using social distancing guidelines.

We have limited the sizes of our enrollment.

Activity spaces will be cleaned daily.

Bathroom facilities are cleaned consistently throughout the day.

We will not be using any shared prop or costume piece items.

Contact surfaces will be cleaned regularly.

Notifying the Dutch Apple / Broadway Bound When

If your child has felt ill or had a temperature (100.4 degrees or higher) 24-48 hours and a minimum of hour before class; symptoms of fever or chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting.

Any child that has someone in their household that has felt ill or been sick in the past 24-48 hours.

Any child or family member who has been potentially exposed to COVID-19 (We ask that in this situation parents respectfully inform the theatre so any other students and staff members can be notified that there has been a potential exposure and can monitor themselves for COVID-19 symptoms.)

Any child or family member that has tested positive for COVID-19, please inform Dutch Apple / Broadway Bound so we can notify those that have been exposed and follow the guidance of a family doctor to make sure they follow CDC recommended safety precautions for COVID-19

Please practice mindfulness of respectfully following the safety procedures.
